## ET'S GET CERTIFIED

BASIC FIRST AID AND CPR ADULT, CHILD/INFANT and AED

This course combines the American Heart Association First Aid and Heart Saver CPR for Adults Infants and Children with AED. Participants learn first aid basics for adults and show proficiency in skills. This course teaches what to do in a life threatening emergency. teaches what to do in a life threatening emergency. These emergencies include not breathing, choking and cardiac arrest (heart stopping) which occurs mostly in or near home. Sudden infant death syndrome and prevention of injuries and choking in infants and children will be discussed. With the knowledge and skills in this course participants will learn the warning signs of heart attack, stroke, cardiac arrest choking and breathing difficulties; CPR and relief of choking for adults, children and infants. Students receive hands on training with the AED. This course has a skills exam and no written test. Participants will receive an AHA Heart Saver two year certification card for Adult First Aid, CPR for adults/children, infants and AED use. Text purchase is not necessary if recertifying. ## 1-DAY SAFE BOATING & PERSONAL WATERCRAFT SAFETY CERTIFICATION

A complete, updated safe boating certification course taught in one (8 hour) day. This class includes the newest requirement for towing skiers & tubes. Successful completion will allow the student to purchase a Connecticut Certificate of Personal Watercraft Operation with Waterski endorsement, which enables them to operate any recreational vessel up to 65 feet in length, with some age restrictions for younger operators. An easy to understand classroom format is designed for students age 12 and over. Create an account if you don't already have one, and then print the page that includes your Conservation ID number and bring it to class.
