Participant line-up 4:00 pm meet on Depot St (behind the cemetery)

STEP - OFF TIME:

4:30 pm to arrive at the Gazebo around 5:00 pm

PARADE ROUTE:

Main Street (corner of French St) to Gazebo - corners of Routes 6 & 63

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- 1. **SAFETY:** Take all safeguards in protecting your participants during line-up, on the Parade Route and at end point with disbursing.
 - The Fire Department entrance, exit and parking lot is active and must be kept clear at all times.
 - Depot Street will <u>not</u> be closed to traffic, so be aware of your surroundings.
 - When you arrive at the Gazebo, **DO NOT DISBURSE**, please continue to the parking lot on the right in front of the Congregational Church for disbursement we must ensure that the Parade does not stop until Santa arrives at the Gazebo.
- 2. **LINE-UP:** We will be lining up on Depot Street behind the cemetery the route will be up French onto Main Street. Line-up time will begin at 4:00pm you will be assigned a position in the Parade when you arrive.
- 3. **ADVERTISING:** Absolutely no advertising on the marchers, participants, vehicles and floats. Every effort should be made to cover any visible advertising.
- 4. HORSES: No horses allowed.
- 5. **THEME**: Fully illuminated light parade to celebrate Santa's arrival in Watertown Santa will be bringing up the rear of the Parade. We are asking all participants, floats, etc. to be "lit up" white lights and all children should sparkle or blink in some manner.
- 6. **HANDING OUT ITEMS**: For insurance and safety purposes **do not throw items** to the crowd. Any items handed out should be done at the festival itself and must be preapproved by Watertown Parks & Recreation.

NOTES

- **PERFORMING:** There is absolutely no stopping along the parade route for any reason. The opportunity to perform can be arranged through Watertown Recreations and will be at the Festival Site
- **WEATHER:** Please ensure all participants are dressed appropriate to the weather. When the sun sets the temperature can drop considerably.
