SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

The Holiday Craft Fair is a fine art and craft show for individual artists to exhibit and sell their <u>original</u>, <u>handmade fine art or craft</u>. Art media accepted (but not limited to) includes: sculpture, pottery, glass, jewelry, painting/drawing, textile/fiber/clothing design, photography, woodworking, musical instruments, leather craft, and metalwork and specialty foods.

EXHIBIT AREA: Exhibit space will be pre-assigned. Exhibit space is approximately 8' X 8' (additional booth space available for an additional fee). Your exhibit area and surrounding area must be left in the same condition you found it. Please limit number of helpers during the event to keep booth(s) less crowded.

ELECTRICITY: Electricity is *NOT* Provided.

ITEMS FOR SALE: All exhibited items must be the "hand" work of the exhibitor. With the craft fair exhibiting handmade items, there may be similar items but everyone has their own unique style! **Ex:** if two vendors are selling jewelry, they will not be placed next to each other but we will have both unique designs available! Only items submitted and approved may be displayed and sold.

RAFFLE: We *ask all vendors to donate a minimum of one item* to be raffled off. Staff will come around to collect your one item. In return you will receive a raffle ticket per item donated to the raffle table.

EVENT INSURANCE: Insurance is not provided.

<u>SET-UP</u>: Saturday, November 29th at 7:30 A.M. You <u>MUST</u> be set-up by 9:45 A.M. <u>Strictly enforced!</u> All vendors <u>MUST</u> bring help to set up and break down your exhibit area. Vendors are to provide own tables, chairs, decorations, etc. Seasonal decorations encouraged. *No early tear downs unless it is an emergency*.

SPECIAL REQUESTS: They must be made at least 2 weeks before the event.

<u>VEHICLES:</u> Vendors are <u>NOT</u> to park in the Swift Middle school parking lot throughout the event. After unloading products, vendors are to move their cars to Mosgrove parking lot (29 Davis Street, Oakville, CT). A Watertown Parks & Recreation staff member will be there to shuttle all vendors back to Swift Middle school for the remainder of the event. After the event, we will shuttle you back to your vehicle. We have close to 50 vendors each year. We need to make sure the parking spots nearest to the building are available for your customers.

PETS: Please do not bring pets to shows.
